OWAKA COMMUNITY FUND UPDATE

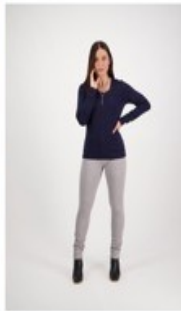
Catlins Historical Society has received \$3,000 from the Owaka Community Fund towards replacing the ageing roof on the Owaka Museum building.
