Yellow-eyed Penguins/Hoiho are shy and easily stressed - do not disturb them, give them space, stay at least 50m away. Do not remove plants, animals or fossils from

the environment – treat New Zealand / Aotearoa forest and birds with respect, they are unique and often rare. · Respect our cultural heritage, treat these places with consideration and care.




